- Bus pick up to transport campers to Wildwood Ranch will be on Sundays at 4:00 PM at the Detroit Rescue Mission Ministries Tabernacle building located at 138 Stimson Street, Detroit 48201. We will not open the doors before 4:00 PM. Parents must come inside and complete the registration process when dropping off a camper. If you arrive at the bus stop after 5:00 PM, your space will be given away. *Please be on time!* If you have planned to bring your child directly to camp, you should arrive at 5:30 PM.
- The bus will return campers to the same location on Fridays at 2:00 PM. Please be on time picking up your child! If you are picking up your child from camp, you should arrive at the camp office at 1:30 PM.
