RESPONSIBLE TO: HEAD WRANGLER ASSOCIATE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR ASSISTANT PROGRAM DIRECTOR (Time Off and Nightly Activities)

QUALIFICATIONS:

In addition to those qualifications listed in the WILDWOOD RANCH JOB DESCRIPTIONS OVERVIEW, the Wrangler should:

- 1. Be at least sixteen (16) years of age.
- 2. Have a desire to live and work in a service position at camp.
- 3. Have experience working with horses, preferably teaching children and youth.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

In addition to those responsibilities listed in the WILDWOOD RANCH JOB DESCRIPTIONS OVERVIEW, the Wrangler should:

1. Learn horse care responsibilities from the Head Wrangler.

2. Maintain stable management and procedures of CHA and ACA, and State Licensing Standards.

- 3. Assist in conducting horsemanship classes and trail rides.
- 4. Assist in feeding, worming and trimming of horses.
- 5. Assist in any maintenance that involves the barn or the horses.
- 6. Clean and sanitize surfaces, equipment, tack, etc. according to Health Department guildines.

7. Assist with all camp evening activities, including chapel, night games and campfires.

TRAINING:
